# Attimo to go close again with conditions to suit

▶ Penmore Mill goes in the same hunters' chase he won last year (3.10 Leicester). Although carrying more weight this time, he looks to have been aimed at this race again after a similar prep run in a point-to-point last time out.

▶In-form Liam Treadwell has an impressive strike-rate of 45 per cent when teaming up with Venetia Williams at Leicester. It looks significant that he comes here for one ride on Belami Des Pictons in the 2.40, whom he is two out of two on.

Running 2m3½ over fences, Attimo has form figures of 112. Trainer Sam England has an impressive 43 per cent strike-rate at Catterick and Attimo should go close under favoured conditions in the 3.20.
