Hitman ready to fire Toon to title

involved with **Invincible Lady** in the second (2.27pm, ignore her poor trial, she cramped and was later sick), and her litter-sister **Some Woman**, who has trap one for Fenwick in the third race, for bitches, who would win any beauty prize! "She's a gorgeous ginger brindle," he said.

He would prefer traps two or three for her. "But what we really wanted was to be inside Ballymac Shirley – who tends to move wide at the boxes."

His bitch is on a five-timer, while Towcester's Ballymac Shirley bids for six in a row for Mark Wallis, rocketing out each time. There is no measure for error, but Some Woman can edge ahead down the back.

Fenwick is also involved in Towcester runner Oldfield Lynda, who is trained by Wallis and goes from trap three in the

sprint (4.08pm). He owns her jointly with Scott Fraser. "Obviously if Oldfield Lynda wins, we're going to claim her points for Newcastle," joked Fenwick.

But Newcastle expects its own runner, **Bramble Bruno**, trained by Steven Anderson, to have raced clear. He is on a six-timer, ran a sparkling trial, and will be hard to hold from trap six.

Paul Young's **Droopys Ambition**, a litter-sister to RFS Puppy Derby hero Droopys Roddick, can get Romford off to a great start in the opening youngsters' race, while the Essex track took the opening race in this year's competition back on September 10 through Philip Simmonds' **Toot Hill Wizard**, who went on to reach the Puppy Cup final. He can make full use of trap one in the 4.47pm.

Towcester is set to score consistently through the afternoon – and runs a St Leger finalist in Wallis's Ferryfront Fran in the fourth over 660m (3.07pm), although he comes up against another Newcastle banker, Jimmy Wright's Shellam Delano,

unbeaten over six bends.

Towcester can end on a winning note with Kevin Hutton's **Reel Style** in the 5.07pm finale, but it may be all over by then, with the Toon Army celebrating.
