NASS Special Merit Award:

For someone who deserves special recognition for their work in the industry and who has to go beyond on a day-to-day basis, achieving triumph in the face of adversity.

What are The Godolphin Stud and Stable Staff Awards?

The Stud and Stable Staff Awards were initiated in 2005 to recognise the achievements of racing's key staff. They are generously sponsored by Godolphin and are run by the British Horseracing Authority, in conjunction with the Racing Post. In further support of the Awards, Godolphin has also increased the prize fund in 2010 to £120,000.

Who can enter this category?

The category is open to any NASS Full Member, currently employed as Stud or Stable Staff within England, Wales or Scotland at the time of nomination. Candidates must be nominated by another NASS Full Member.

The winner will be decided by the NASS Executive Council, with an independent observer present and excluding any of the Executive Council members if they are candidates.

What is the prize for this Award category?

The winner of the award will be awarded £5,000.



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
